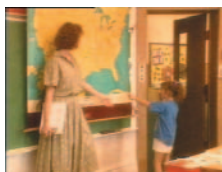


Our newest program

general education classroom and illustrates the support systems that facilitate the inclusion.

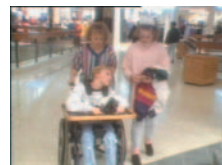
Inclusion: Issues for Educators

This popular program examines how inclusion often begins at school and focuses on two students who, with their friends from school, participate in typical community activities. It explores the

encouraging effect such participation has on their families' views of their children's future.

Step by Step: Heather's Story



This best selling documentary begins when Heather, a girl with Down Syndrome, is 8 years old and in "special ed." It follows her through two years and into the fourth grade in a general educa-

tion classroom. Seeing is believing and this two-year, longitudinal study enables viewers to watch Heather blossom. It also provides the opportunity to watch her teachers, principal, family, and classmates work together and grow along with her.
